La Pedrera - Casa Milà

Spain

La Pedrera – Casa Milà is one of Antoni Gaudí's most celebrated architectural masterpieces, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a symbol of Barcelona's modernisme. Mosaics Torra was entrusted with reproducing and reinstalling our iconic Hexagonal Gaudí tile in two key rooms: the children's bedroom of Gaudí himself, and one of the main living rooms. We helped recover the original geometry, texture and spirit of the space — respecting its history while restoring its beauty.

Palau de la Música Catalana

The Palau de la Música Catalana is a jewel of Catalan modernisme and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, renowned for its rich ornamentation and architectural harmony. As part of a comprehensive restoration, Mosaics Torra was responsible for restoring all the flooring throughout the corridors, stairways, and main concert hall, as well as various rooms and interior spaces of the building. The original hydraulic tile designs were faithfully reproduced, preserving the authenticity and artistic integrity of this iconic cultural landmark.





Located within the iconic Park Güell, the pink house known today as the Casa Museu Gaudí was once the residence of Antoni Gaudí himself, and now serves as a museum dedicated to his life and work. Surrounded by Gaudí's architectural vision, this house is an essential part of Barcelona's modernist heritage.

As part of a careful restoration project, Mosaics Torra reproduced all the original mosaic tile carpets throughout the interior rooms, bringing back the authentic look and feel of the hydraulic cement flooring that once defined the space. Every detail was faithfully recreated to reflect the textures, colors, and patterns that Gaudí himself would have lived with — preserving the spirit of the house with precision and respect.























Hospital de Sant Pau

The Hospital de Sant Pau – Recinte Modernista is one of the largest Art Nouveau complexes in the world, designed by Lluís Domènech i Montaner and declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This extraordinary ensemble of pavilions, gardens and galleries stands as a masterpiece of Catalan modernisme and a symbol of architectural innovation and beauty.

Mosaics Torra was entrusted with reproducing the original hydraulic tiles used throughout the site. We carefully restored the floors of corridors, rooms, and key spaces, faithfully recreating the historical patterns to maintain the visual identity and cultural significance of this unique architectural landmark.



Hotel Villa Maria Cristina

Hotel Villa María Cristina is a luxury boutique hotel located in the historic city of Guanajuato, Mexico — a Heritage Site known for its colonial architecture, vibrant culture, and artistic heritage. Nestled in a 19th-century mansion, the hotel combines classic elegance with modern comfort.

As part of a major restoration project, Mosaics Torra was commissioned to reproduce and restore the cement tile flooring throughout most of the hotel's indoor and outdoor spaces, including terraces, corridors, and common areas. The intervention respected the building's original aesthetics, combining faithful reproductions of traditional patterns with high-quality craftsmanship to preserve the soul and sophistication of this exceptional destination.

Residence in the Gothic quarter
